

NAPLAN Online 2017

You may have heard that NAPLAN online is being introduced across Australia from 2017, with the aim for all Australian schools to be administering NAPLAN online by 2019.

NAPLAN online will provide better assessment, more precise results and faster turnaround of information. Your child's results will be returned to you more quickly, within a couple of weeks rather than a couple of months.

NAPLAN (National Literacy and Numeracy Assessment) will take place on Tuesday 9th, Wednesday 10th, Thursday 11th and Friday 12th of May 2017. Attendance is compulsory for all **Year 7** and **Year 9** students unless prior exemption or withdrawal arrangements have been made. All students are encouraged to make their best effort in each of the tests.

The following is an outline of the organisation for the days. Please note that the schedule includes time for log on and setup as well as testing. Students will return to their normal scheduled classes after completion.

Students should bring the following items: pencil, eraser and a book to read after testing.

Chrome books and headsets will be provided for student use.
