Welcome to the MCSS 2018 School Year

We have had a great start to the school year with students across both campuses now settling in to the busy school routine. The summer break over, students and staff are now looking to the semester 1 activities and a build-up of school work and a range of extra-curricular enrichment activities.

Exciting news for students is the **ACT Government School Chromebook Rollout** for all students in Years 7-11. The Year 7-10 students receive their devices on Monday 12 February and Year 11 will have to wait until Wednesday 21 February. Please return your authorisation notes if you wish to access a Chromebook for your student.

At the beginning of this year we have commenced our transition to the NEW School Administration System (SAS). This Education Directorate led system aims to maximise the efficiency of the administration in our schools. At present, the transition to this system is in phases with the first concentrating on attendance. This change means that the previous digital roll marking tool we used – APPSENCE – will no longer be used. After week 3 this term we will be activating the SMS functionality of the program that will alert you of any variation to your child's attendance in each lesson.

Later this month a comprehensive newsletter full of celebrations and students experiences will be distributed.
